Declaration on Public Country-by-Country Reporting for the Enterprises of the multinational Group JSC Samruk-Kazyna

The report on information related to corporate income tax for the reporting period of 2023, ending on December 31, 2023 ("FY2023"), also referred to as the public country-by-country reporting ("Public CbC Report" or "Report"), concerning the enterprises of the multinational group JSC Samruk-Kazyna Group ("Group"), has been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 13^1 of Order 1802/2014 for the approval of Accounting regulations regarding the individual and consolidated annual financial statements, as well as Chapter 8^1 of Order 2844/2016 for the approval of Accounting regulations compliant with International Financial Reporting Standards, as further amended and completed. The data and information contained in the Report pertain exclusively to the operations of the JSC Samruk-Kazyna Group in Romania. The public CbC Report does not include information regarding the Group's operations in other jurisdictions, as such information has not been made available to the entities in Romania by the Group's ultimate parent company for the reasons outlined below:

- Romania introduced the requirements for publishing the CbC report two years earlier than other European Union member states, where the obligation to present such information will take effect starting with the 2025 calendar year. Under these circumstances, the disclosure of centralized information regarding operational activities, financial data, and detailed tax information by fiscal jurisdictions where the Group operates could be a sensitive issue, potentially jeopardizing the Group's competitive position and strategic initiatives, especially given that this information would be disclosed two years before other companies are subject to a similar obligation.
- The JSC Samruk-Kazyna Group consistently aims to comply with tax and accounting regulations and compliance standards in every jurisdiction where it operates. However, the early implementation of the disclosure requirements for Public CbcC purposes may place the Group at a disadvantage.
- The requirement to publish the report in a readable electronic format, in the absence of a predefined structure issued by authorities, leaves room for uncertainty and interpretation.

As an alternative to publishing the report on the entity's/subsidiary's/branch's
website, the law provides the option to simultaneously make the report
available to the public in a readable format on the online registry mentioned
in Directive (EU) 2017/1132, as transposed into national legislation, and free
of charge to any third party within the Union. The fact that no procedures have
yet been published in this regard makes the process of publishing the Report
even more uncertain and challenging.

Therefore, considering the reasons outlined above, including the lack of detailed guidelines on how to efficiently complete and submit the required information, at this stage, regarding the obligation for the Public CbC Report, the Group opts to provide information exclusively for entities in Romania.

At the same time, the JSC Samruk-Kazyna Group intends to present complete information starting with the 2025 calendar year, when the Public CbC Report will become a standard practice for all large multinational groups operating in the European Union, which will then face similar compliance requirements.
